It took us some time to analyze, rank, take stock of your 243 proposals and understand the numerous urban issues you are exploring. We also needed to bring together a larger number of qualified persons to accompany us with regards to your key issues.

Nevertheless, the next stages have now been set out.

On April 3rd, 4th and 5th, a wide-ranging panel of experts is going to appraise and judge your projects. This panel, of which the still non-exhaustive list currently comprises officials and representatives of the City of Paris, of institutions (Regional order of architects in the greater

Paris area, French Ministry of Culture and Communication, French national architecture schools, Paris 2024 Candidacy Committee, C40, etc.), construction professionals (engineers, design firms, consulting firms, etc.) materials and repurposing professionals, housing specialists (urban planners, housing associations, etc.) and specialists in urban solidarity (key players, designers, users etc.), experts in public spaces and mobility (think tanks, industrial firms, public transport agencies, etc.), well-known figures in design and new technologies... who have all accepted to come and examine your projects.

The teams whose projects are selected will be invited to come and pitch their idea at the Pavillon de l'Arsenal on the morning of April 24th and the results will be announced that evening.
